Main Idea: *In God's kingdom-perspective, the definition of family changes from physical DNA to spiritual DNA.*

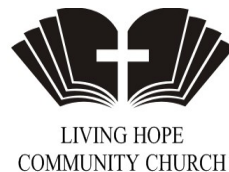
We need to answer these two questions regarding our relationship with Jesus so that we might know that we are part of His spiritual family.
